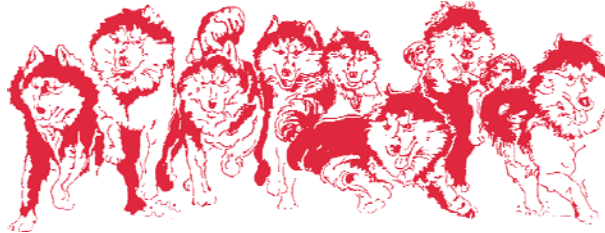

Re: **CHANGES TO THE BEGINNING AND ENDING OF SCHOOL DAY AND TRANSPORTATION**

Beginning July 1, 2011, the Olean City School District will begin sharing transportation with the Portville and Hinsdale transportation departments. This will mean significant savings for the district which is necessary with the difficult financial status of our local and state economy. Transportation sharing will change the beginning and ending times at the elementary schools only. The high school and middle school times will remain the same.

The schedule for all elementary students:

Y-Care Program	Y-Care begins at 7:35 a.m. through 8:20 a.m.
Morning Bus Arrival Times	Between 8:15 a.m. through 8:30 a.m.
Breakfast To Be Served	Begin at 8:30 a.m. and end at 8:50 a.m.
Student to go to rooms for attendance	8:50 a.m.
Afternoon Walker Dismissal Time	3:10 p.m.
Afternoon Bus Dismissal Time	3:15 p.m.

Parents and guardians who have children that ride the bus will receive more information once the pickup times are confirmed. This information will include:

- Pick up times and locations,
- Name of school bus district (Portville or Hinsdale) that will pick up your child(ren),
- Animal symbol on elementary bus, and
- Bus number for middle school and high school students.

An important note: The bus schedule must be strictly adhered to. Therefore if your child(ren) misses the bus, the district will not be able to come back and pick up your child(ren). To avoid any disruption in your child(ren)s education, please make sure that they are ready when the bus arrives.

As the district strives to save money and keep programs for our students, sharing transportation services will help to achieve that goal. The District thanks you in advance for your cooperation in this new venture as together we can reduce costs and maintain quality programming.
